

YOUR FIRST LAB DAY IS APPROACHING - WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

ESSENTIAL: DO THE SAFETY OWL, THE COURSE POLICY OWL, AND HAVE A GOOD PRELAB OUTLINE BEFORE COMING TO LAB. IF YOU HAVE NOT DONE ALL OF THESE THINGS YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WORK IN THE LAB. PURCHASE EYE PROTECTION AND BRING IT TO LAB. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WORK IN THE LAB WITHOUT ACCEPTIBLE EYE PROTECTION.

BEFORE YOU COME TO LAB

PRINT OUT HANDOUT FOR EXPERIMENT AND PHOTOS OF LAB EQUIPMENT (FROM WEBSITE).

USING HANDOUT AS A REFERENCE, DO OWL PRELAB ASSIGNMENT BY DEADLINE.

BASED ON HANDOUT AND OWL ASSIGNMENT, WRITE A GOOD PRELAB OUTLINE.

(TEST OF A GOOD OUTLINE ->
CAN YOU DO THE EXP USING ONLY THE OUTLINE?)

GO TO LAB (LGRT-301) AND WAIT OUTSIDE UNTIL ASKED TO ENTER.

WRITE DOWN YOUR LOCKER NUMBER (POSTED JUST OUTSIDE OF LAB).

PUT ON EYE PROTECTION, ENTER LAB, FIND YOUR LOCKER. (low numbers are near entrance, 30's mid-lab, 60's far end)

MEET YOUR TA, CHECK EQUIPMENT AGAINST LIST (photo of equipment on 269 website), REPLACE MISSING/BROKEN EQUIPMENT, TURN IN EXTRA EQUIPMENT, KEEP LOCKER KEY FOR SEMESTER, GIVE LIST TO TA.

AFTER TA GIVES PRELAB TALK, CHECKS OUTLINE, AND GIVES THE OK, BEGIN WORK.

KEEP GOOD NOTES AS YOU WORK - SEE LINK ON CHEM 269 WEBSITE FOR SAMPLE REPORT.

WHEN FINISHED, CLEAN UP WORK AREA, LOCK DRAWER, AND GET TA SIGNATURE.

BEFORE NEXT LAB

IN THE SAME WAY PREPARE FOR NEXT EXP, AND DO POSTLAB OWL AND FINISH WRITE-UP FOR PREVIOUS EXP.
